Academically, English literacy, mathematics, and French literacy are the foundation upon which our Elementary School is built. In the early years, it is critical that the skills of speaking, listening, reading, writing, numeracy, and problemsolving get the attention they deserve. As students progress through our Elementary program, our academic offerings expand to include science, social studies, music, art, physical education, health, and religion.

Why choose between English only or French Immersion when you can have the best of both worlds at Sacred Heart? We offer a unique alternative, one that includes **both English and French language from the start**. Exposure to French starts in the JP and Primary programs with three French classes weekly, and is built upon in our Grade 1-2 Bilingual Program, where children spend half their day in English and half in French. As a result, they develop listening, speaking, reading, and writing capabilities in both languages. In Grades 3-6, our students continue with daily French. Once our students reach the Senior School, they're well poised to continue with more advanced French, and onward to full DELF (Diplôme d'études en langue française) bilingual certification.
